This 60 km itinerary around the Brussels region links the various green areas of the city via circuitous routes reserved for pedestrians and cyclists, and allows you to discover a multitude of landscapes and natural environments. From the Soignes forest to the Heysel plateau, via the Neerpeede and the Woluwe park, get on your bike for a radical greening in a friendly atmosphere.

The Green Promenade can be walked in either direction.

This is a completely self-guided tour, accompanied by a roadbook that will emerge you in a green world.

CULTURAL NATURE AND WELLBEING BETWEEN LEGENDS AND HISTORY IN THE FORÊT DE SOIGNES





Only 4 km from the city center, the Forêt de Soignes covers 45 km² at the gates of Brussels. Jump in the saddle and, with the help of the road book, discover this real green lung, classified as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2017. Go in search of the places and monuments that dot the forest. Find the old abbey of Groenendael, the valley of the drowned children, the Queen's chapel or Notre Dame de Bonne Odeur, all of which are places of legend and history.
